

KRSCP Child Safeguarding Practice Reviews

Within 5 days

Serious Safeguarding Incident Occurs
(where abuse or neglect of a child is known or suspected and the child has died or been seriously injured)

Complete the Serious Incident Form → **Notify**

- The National Panel & Ofsted
- The Met Police Specialist Crime Review Group (SCRG)
- Statutory Safeguarding Partners-CDOP if child death
- (if CLA) – Secretary of State and Ofsted

Within 15-40 days

Local Learning Review Subgroup conduct a Rapid Review or Serious Incident Review of the case and consider whether the case meets the criteria for a local review / JAR (Joint Agency Review) takes place if child death

Statutory Partners submit copy of the Rapid Review to the National Panel for consideration or a national review (including outcome of decision to conduct a local review)

Statutory Partners decide to conduct a local review

Safeguarding Partners inform:

- Ofsted
- Department of Education & local Partners

Within 6 months

A national review will be carried out

A national review will not be carried out

A national review begins (will be requested to contribute to the review)

Submit a copy of the full report to:

- Secretary of State
- Statutory Safeguarding Partners
- Ofsted
- Care Quality Commission
- Her Majesty's Inspectorate of Constabulary & Fire & Rescue Services

National final full/redacted CSPR published

Safeguarding Partners commission reviewer and agreed method of local review

Safeguarding Partners consider final report and agree information will be published

7 working days before publication

Submit a copy of the full report to:

- The National Panel
- Secretary of State
- Ofsted
